CHS Can Give Day Virtual Dog Show

As part of activities to involve the community, have some fun and raise much needed funds for Can Give Day, Cancer and Ambulatory Support Executive Team is organising a virtual Dog Show!

The way it will work:

Applications will be submitted to chs.cas@act.gov.au which will include completing the attached form and submitting up to 3 photos of your dog.

Cost: \$30 per entry – evidence of donating \$30 to Canberra Hospital Foundation's Can Give Day will need to be submitted with the application, or \$30 in cash (Payable to the CAS Executive office).

Each applicant can then garner 'votes' in the form of donations – these can be on the above webpage with the name of the dog you are supporting in the comments field.

OR

By cash donations direct to the owner. The owner needs to submit cash donations to the CAS Executive team no later than 2pm on Wednesday 25th of November.

The first 3 dogs based on the amount of money raised for that dog will be declared the winners at 4pm on Wednesday 25th November. The 3 winning dogs will be invited to a prize ceremony on the CANGIVE stage on Thursday 26th November.

Whilst this is a dog show, applications for any domestically housed animals will be accepted and they stand an equal chance of winning if they raise enough money!

Funds raised will go to the 'Delta Dogs' therapy dog program.
